Research focus: personhood in law and principles of law

Principles of law, especially the Rule of Law; Comparative and European citizenship and personhood in law from quantitative and qualitative perspective; equality and non-discrimination; federalism.

My academic work includes **3 monographs** (2 published, 1 on-contract, not including translations); **14 edited volumes** (11 published, 3 on-contract) of which **5 with Cambridge** University Press, **3 with Hart** Publishing and **2 with Oxford** University Press; more than 100 articles and contributions to books.

Among the grants I won is **EUR 1M Mercator Stiftung** grant to establish clinical Rule of Law work and several Horizon work packages over the years around EUR 0.3M each. I have expertise on the **ERC** assessment panels (ERC advanced), holistic national research quality assessments (in 2019 I served on the international expert panel assessing political science and law research in Portugal) and Fulbright as well as a handful of national funding schemes all around the EU, from Luxembourg to the Netherlands, Poland and Slovenia. My work has been featured in *The Economist*, *The New York Review of Books*, *New York Times*, *The New Yorker* (online), *The Financial Times*, *Le Monde* etc.
